### Today's Readings

**Mission Day** – The Archdeacon is holding a Mission Day on Saturday 10th December for the people of Saint Luke's. This will be an all-day session and we would strongly recommend anyone from the congregation to come along. It is expected that all the PCC members will come. This will be a very worthwhile exercise and will help us in encouraging Church growth.

**Gideons International** – The next issue of the Gideons Newsletter is now on the table at the back of church. As always there are a few copies for anybody wishing to take one. Mike and Beryl Dayus will be here at Saint Luke's on **6th November** at the 10.00 am Mass, to talk about the Gideons International and what they are doing in this country and abroad. **Church Heating** - Please do *not* leave doors open – either to the outside or between the church and the Parish Centre. The church main door will usually be latched open before the Sunday services, but we are asking the Welcomers to take it off the latch once the service has begun. On weekdays, the door will remain off the latch – just push to open. Please do not leave the glass swing doors latched open. It is also a timely reminder to people that we cannot hope to heat the church up to the standard of your living room! Please dress appropriately for whatever the weather conditions outside. Time to pack away the shorts and t-shirts!

**Coughs and sneezes spread diseases** - but so do germs on unwashed hands! The clergy try to minimise the spread of infections such as colds and flu by washing hands before the service and using the bactericidal gel during the service. Our Eucharistic Ministers follow a similar procedure. We advise our regulars to do the same. You will find a gel dispenser on the table at the back of church; we encourage you to use it when you arrive at church. Remember that at the Sign of Peace, it is perfectly adequate to smile and nod to someone, rather than shake their hand (or even more!). You should certainly do this if you yourself have an infection. Thank you for your co-operation.

**South Pacific - Wednesday 8th February 2012** - just to say to those who had signed up that the seats are now reserved. The basic cost for the seat will be £23.50 for the stalls. We shall be investigating the best way to provide transport. Further information will be posted as soon as it is available.

**All Souls' Day – Wednesday 2nd November** - Mass will be offered for the repose of the souls of the faithful departed at 9.30 am and at 7 pm. You will find lists at the back of church for you to enter the names of those who wish mentioned at the mass which you yourself hope to attend. Please *print* the names *clearly*. Names of the Parish Chantry Book will not automatically be read out.

**Servers** - it would help the clergy enormously if there were an adult member of the congregation present with the servers both before and after mass on a Sunday. This is also a requirement of Safeguarding. The job could be shared by a number of people; it only requires you to be in the Severs' Vestry from about 9.45 am and help them get vested and organised; also, just at the end of mass to help them disrobe and tidy up. A volunteer to occasionally launder the servers' albs would be a great help, too.  
In both instances, if you are interested, have a word with the clergy.

**CREATIVE GYMNASIUM (50+)** - This is an exciting participatory arts project in partnership with Age UK. Antonia Beck, who is the Project Manager and Theatre Practitioner of the Belgrade Theatre, is coming to talk to us at the coffee morning after the 9.30 am service on Thursday 3rd November to explain all about it.
