New Bishop of Ebbsfleet – the Archbishop of Canterbury has recently announced that he has appointed Revd. Dr. Jonathan Baker to be the next Bishop of Ebbsfleet. Fr. Baker, although only in his early forties, has established himself as a prominent member within the Church of England and particularly General Synod where he has worked hard to represent the catholic constituency. He is much liked and respected by the clergy. He is at present Principal of Pusey House, Oxford. His episcopal ordination will be on Thursday 16th June at Southwark Cathedral, though he will probably not be assuming full responsibility for the Ebbsfleet area until early September. Until then Bishop Lindsay will continue to look after the Ebbsfleet parishes in the Coventry Diocese.
