Important News – As you may have already discovered from television or the Press, Bishop Andrew has tendered his resignation and indicated his intention, along with four other bishops, of joining the Roman Catholic Church, through the new Anglican Ordinariate, which will be set up in the early new year. You should have received Bishop Andrew's final Pastoral Letter and this will explain much to you. However, if you do wish for further information, please have a word with one of the clergy. It is now certain that Bishop Andrew will be replaced and Fr. Kit is a member of the Ebbsfleet Council of Priests which will have a key role to play in the appointment of a new Bishop of Ebbsfleet. Please pray that the right man, at this difficult time, will be found for the job. In addition, several priests up and down the country have indicated that they will be joining Bishop Andrew in the Ordinariate. So far, Father Graham Marcer, from our sister church of Saint Nicholas, Radford, has indicated that he will be resigning his post on Shrove Tuesday 2011 and will join the Ordinariate. News of other movements will be posted as soon as they are made public.

Meeting with Bishop Christopher – you should have received today a copy of a letter from the Bishop of Coventry. He is inviting all concerned to join him for a meeting here at Saint Luke's on **Thursday 2nd December** at 7.30 pm, with refreshments from 7 pm and ending with Compline. Do please put this date in your diary and make attendance at this a priority.

Annual Memorial Service – a big "thank you" to all those who attended and helped with the service last week. It was particularly good to see our members creating a warm welcome and engaging our visitors in friendly conversation at tea afterwards.

Christmas Raffle 2010 – There will be three bumper hampers to raffle off at the annual Carol Service. We can only do this with your very generous help with items for the hampers and your co-operation in selling the tickets. Could everyone please take two books per person on a buy one, sell one, plan.
