Ash Wednesday begins this Wednesday. Mass with ash ceremonies at 9.30 am and 7.00 pm. Begin Lent the way you mean to go on, with a good start on Ash Wednesday. See you there.

Next Sunday will be the First Sunday of Lent and will be a Parade Service, when we again welcome the members of our Uniformed Organisations.

The ACS has generously funded our Parish for many years so it is only right that we should focus our Lenten almsgiving on this very worthy cause.
